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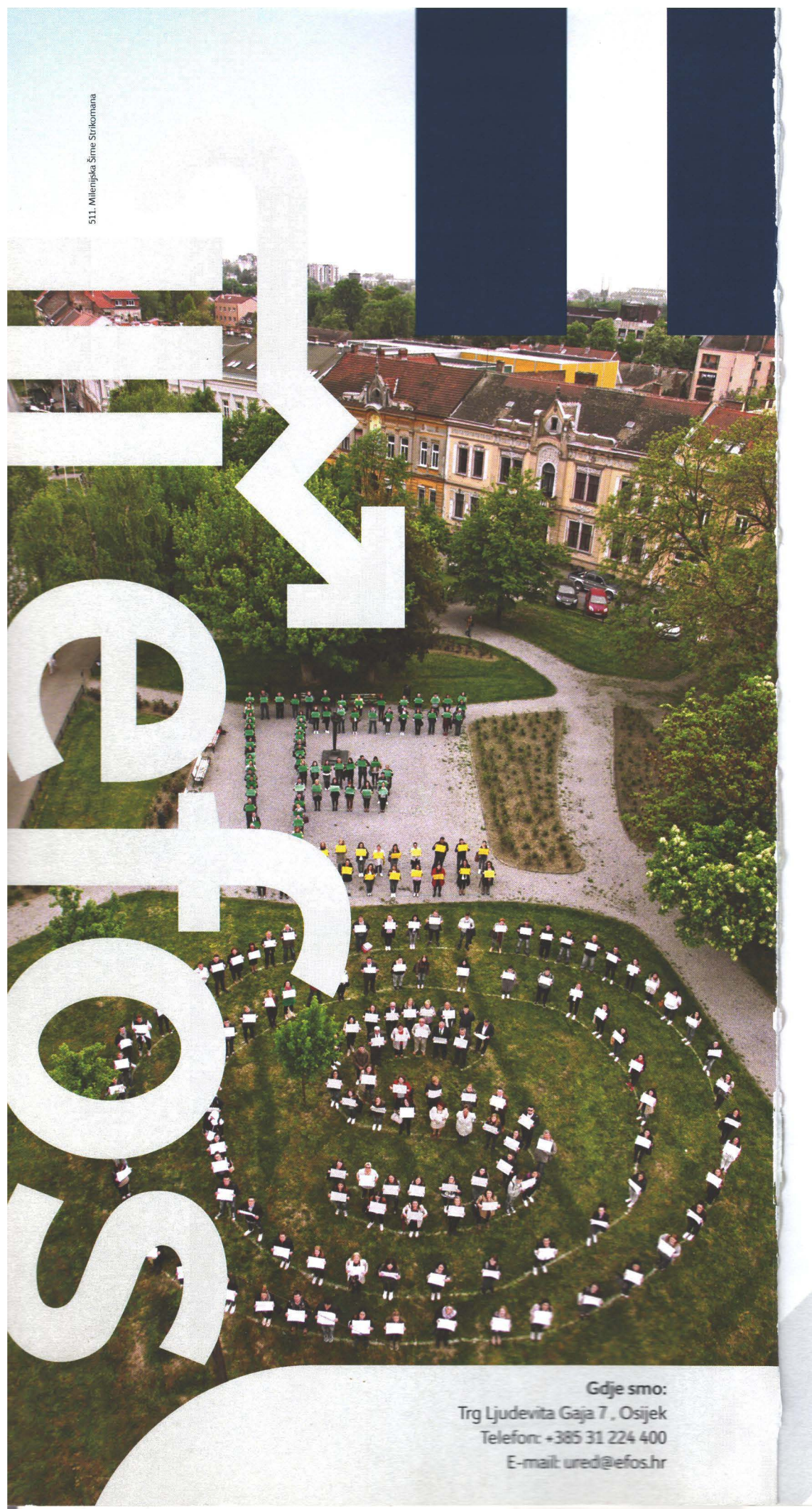




Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku



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Riječ dekana

Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku jedan je od najstarijih fakulteta i visokoobrazovnih institucija u Osijeku i Slavoniji i Baranji te od svojih prvih dana postojanja teži svojem pozicioniranju kao autonomna, moderna, komparativno-kompetitivna ustanova bliska europskoj i svjetskoj kvaliteti nastavnog i znanstveno-istraživačkog rada.


Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku odigrao je znakovitu ulogu u obrazovanju znanstvenika i stručnjaka u ovom dijelu Hrvatske. Naš najveći uspjeh su naši studenti, ljudi koji su završili studij na Fakultetu i koji danas obnašaju najodgovornije funkcije u gospodarstvu, državnoj upravi i lokalnoj i regionalnoj samoupravi, ne samo u regiji, nego i u cijeloj Hrvatskoj. Do ožujka 2018. godine na Fakultetu je diplomiralo 9 566 studenata na dodiplomskom, 3 375 studenata na preddiplomskom i 2 779 studenata na diplomskom studiju, 601 student je završio poslijediplomski specijalistički studij, 691 student je magistrirao, a 268 studenata je doktoriralo.

Snaga Fakulteta počiva, prije svega, na visokoobrazovanim i visokomotiviranim nastavnicima i znanstvenicima koji su nositelj svih ključnih aktivnosti fakulteta. Na fakultetu je trenutno zaposleno 49 nastavnika u znanstveno nastavnom zvanju (redoviti i izvanredni profesori, docenti) i 18 suradnika i nastavnika (asistenata i predavača). Kvaliteti nastavnog procesa uvelike pridonosi i angažman velikog broja vanjskih suradnika koji su priznati stručnjaci iz gospodarskog života. Entuzijazam i novi pogledi velikog broja mladih nastavnika, uz bogatstvo iskustva zrelih generacija, dragocjeni su kao polazna točka budućeg razvoja fakulteta.

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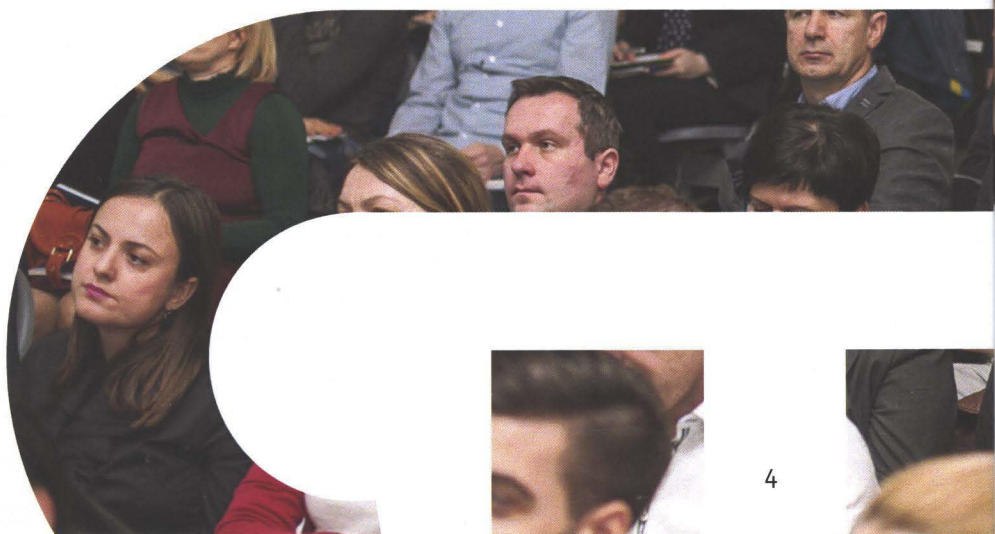


U svojoj, više od 50 godina dugoj, povijesti kako su se mijenjale vanjske okolnosti tako se mijenjao i Fakultet. Promjene su se prije svega odnosile na prilagođavanje studijskih programa Fakulteta potrebama tržišta rada. Tako se od 2005. godine na Fakultetu studira po studijskim programima prilagođenim Bolonjskom sustavu. Na Fakultetu se danas izvodi cjelokupna obrazovna vertikala sveučilišnih studija od preddiplomskog do doktorskog studija. Resursi Fakulteta i veliki broj visokoobrazovanih nastavnika omogućuju Fakultetu razvoj kvalitetnih studijskih programa koji se razvijaju i u dubinu i u širinu. Na Fakultetu se danas može studirati na šest studijskih programa poslovne ekonomije i jednom programu ekonomije. Uz to veliki broj izbornih kolegija omogućuje studentima prilagodbu studijskog programa njihovim vlastitim preferencijama i željama.

O Osijeku

Osijek je grad u istočnoj Hrvatskoj, smješten je na desnoj obali rijeke Drave. Najveći je grad u Slavoniji, a četvrti po veličini grad u Republici Hrvatskoj te je sjedište Osječko-baranjske županije. Osijek je već stoljećima značajno političko, kulturno i trgovačko, a u zadnje vrijeme i turističko središte ovoga dijela Hrvatske. U samome gradu živi 84 000 stanovnika, a na području administrativnoga područja grada (naselje Osijek i 10 prigradskih naselja) 108 048 stanovnika (popis iz 2011.). Tradicija visokoga obrazovanja u Osijeku postoji još od 1707. godine, kada je u Osijeku osnovana prva visokoškolska ustanova. Danas na Sveučilištu Josipa Jurja Strossmayera u Osijeku studira oko 16 500 studenata.





O Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku

Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku jedan je od najstarijih fakulteta Sveučilišta Josipa Jurja Strossmayera u Osijeku. Osnovan je 1961. godine, kao nastavak aktivnosti Centra za ekonomski studij zagrebačkoga sveučilišta, a uz veliku podršku tadašnjega gospodarstva, gospodarske komore, te institucija lokalne i regionalne vlasti. Ta „*regionalna*“ utemeljenost odredila je od samoga početka i profil Fakulteta: u istraživačkome radu usmjerenoga k problemima regionalnoga razvoja i razvoja poduzeća, a u obrazovnim programima usmjerenoga k problematici organizacije poslovanja i upravljanja poduzećem.

Na Fakultetu je zaposleno 67 djelatnika u znanstveno-nastavnim i suradničkim zvanjima te 35 stručno-administrativnog, tehničkog i pomoćnog osoblja. Svojim predanim radom, svi oni, teže povećanju kvalitete usluge i prepoznatljivosti Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku kao centra izvrsnosti.

Ono što ga čini drugačijim od ostalih fakulteta jesu brojne mogućnosti koje pruža svojim studentima: velik broj studijskih programa na svim razinama obrazovanja, brojne izvannastavne aktivnosti u kojima studenti razvijaju svoja znanja i vještine te povećavaju svoju zapošljivost, suradnja na nacionalnoj i međunarodnoj razini s institucijama visokoga obrazovanja i gospodarskim subjektima na različitim znanstvenim i stručnim projektima, kao i projektima mobilnosti kroz Erasmus+ program. Neka od europskih sveučilišta s kojima Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku ima potpisane ugovore o bilateralnoj suradnji su: University of Vienna, University of Business in Prague, Universitat Augsburg, HHL Leipzig Graduate School of Management, Pforzheim University, University of Malaga, Murcia University, Kaposvar University, University of Pecs, University of Bari Aldo Moro, Hanze University of Applied Sciences Groningen.

Kao dokaz kvalitete znanstvenoistraživačkoga rada, obrazovnoga procesa, ali i organizacije poslovanja i sustava upravljanja organizacijom, Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku nositelj je nekoliko akreditacija kvalitete: akreditacije Agencije za znanost i visoko obrazovanje Republike Hrvatske (čime dokazuje da



zadovoljava sve zakonske uvjete za uspješno obavljanje svoje djelatnosti u Republici Hrvatskoj) te akreditacije IQA (CEEMAN International Quality Accreditation) kojom se potvrđuju visoka kvaliteta programa i njegova realizacija, kadrovski potencijal i opremljenost, ali i konačni rezultati obavljanja djelatnosti. Kao potvrda uspješnoga sustava upravljanja organizacijom, svjedoči i Certifikat o ispunjavanju norme ISO 9001:2008 koji je Fakultet dobio 2013. godine, kao i Certifikat ISO 22301 koji je Fakultet dobio 2016. godine.

Od 2008. godine Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku ima i UNESCO katedru za poduzetništvo koja se dodjeljuje institucijama i pojedincima za iznimna postignuća u određenome području.

Kroz svoju viziju i misiju Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku dokazuje svoju predanost poticanju i ostvarenju izvrsnosti u svojoj znanstvenoistraživačkoj i nastavnoj aktivnosti kao važnome preduvjetu ostvarenja napretka i konkurentnosti društva u kojemu živi i djeluje.

Vizija

Vizija je Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku biti prepoznatljiv razvijajući se na standardu izvrsnosti u obrazovanju i razvoju budućih *poslovnih lidera*, izgrađivanjem i održavanjem vodećih ekonomskih stručnjaka i poslovnih ljudi na regionalnoj, državnoj i međunarodnoj razini.

Misija

Misija je Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku jačati kvalitetu visokoškolskoga obrazovanja kroz nastavu, znanstvenoistraživački rad te neprekidnu suradnju s drugim visokoškolskim institucijama i gospodarskim subjektima.

Misija Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku je kroz akademsko i cjeloživotno obrazovanje u polju ekonomije i poslovne ekonomije obrazovati studente sposobne za društveno ekonomski razvitak Hrvatske.

Usvajati znanstvene stečevine, kritički ih valorizirati i kreirati nova znanja kroz znanstveno-istraživački rad u polju ekonomije i s njom povezanih znanosti. Biti društveno odgovorna institucija visokih akademskih vrijednosti i etičkih načela koja osigurava jednakost i prosperitet svojim članovima, studentima i društvu u cjelini.

Opremljenost Fakulteta

U strateškim opredjeljenjima Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku posebna pozornost posvećena je sustavnom unaprjeđenju informatičke tehnologije i proširenju obrazovnih sadržaja koji se neposredno oslanjaju na iskorištavanje ICT-a. Primjena Bolonjske deklaracije rezultirala je uvođenjem novih obrazovnih sadržaja u kojima se potiče kreativno korištenje informacijsko-komunikacijske tehnologije. Već sada se na Fakultetu izvode neki programi pomoću sustava učenja na daljinu, što omogućava praćenje studijskih programa i studentima koji su geografski udaljeni i nisu u mogućnosti doći u Osijek.

Na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku studentima je na raspolaganju više od 200 osobnih računala. Sve učionice Ekonomskoga fakulteta opremljene su multimedijalnom opremom za kvalitetno izvođenje obrazovnoga procesa (računalo priključeno na internet, projektor i ozvučenje), a na raspolaganju je i pametna ploča. Oprema se neprekidno obnavlja i prilagođava najnovijim trendovima u ICT industriji.



Studijski programi na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku

Na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku trenutno studira oko 3 000 studenata na neke od obrazovnih programa preddiplomske, diplomske ili poslijediplomske razine.

Nastava je na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku organizirana u skladu s bolonjskom reformom na tri razine sveučilišnoga obrazovanja: preddiplomskoj, diplomskoj i poslijediplomskoj, na kojima se nude studijski programi ekonomije i poslovne ekonomije (Slika 1.).

U 57 godina postojanja Fakulteta na njemu je diplomiralo je 12 345 studenata, akademski naziv sveučilišnog prvostupnika ekonomije dobilo je 3 375 studenata, dok je titulu stručnog prvostupnika ekonomije dobio 991 student. Poslijediplomske studije, od njihovoga utemeljenja 1973. godine, završio je 1 828 studenata, od toga je 691 student stekao akademski stupanj magistra znanosti, 601 student je stekao akademski naziv sveučilišnog specijaliste, dok je na Fakultetu doktoriralo 268 doktora znanosti.

Preddiplomski stručni studij

Preddiplomski stručni studij na Ekonomskom fakultetu u Osijeku traje tri godine (šest semestara), a studenti mogu odabrati jedan od dva ponuđena studija: preddiplomski stručni studij Računovodstvo ili preddiplomski stručni studij Trgovina. Završetkom studija student stječe 180 ECTS bodova



i zvanje stručni/a prvostupnik/prvostupnica (baccalaureus/ baccalaurea) ekonomije ili skraćeno bacc.oec.

Najvažnija karakteristika ovog studija ogleda se u činjenici što priprema studente za samostalan i praktičan rad po završetku studija. Studij obuhvaća teorijska i praktična znanja koja su izravno primjenjiva u praksi te su nužna u izvršavanju svakodnevnih poslova i zadataka.

Preddiplomski sveučilišni studij

Preddiplomski sveučilišni studij na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku traje tri godine (6 semestara) i njegovim završetkom student stječe 180 ECTS bodova i akademski naziv sveučilišni/a prvostupnik/prvostupnica (baccalaureus/baccalaurea) ekonomije ili skraćeno univ. bacc. oec.

Na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku postoji 6 studijskih programa na preddiplomskoj razini, 1 iz područja ekonomije: Ekonomska politika i regionalni razvitak i 5 iz područja poslovne ekonomije: Financijski menadžment, Menadžment, Marketing, Poduzetništvo i Poslovna informatika.

Završetkom preddiplomskoga sveučilišnoga studija, student je osposobljen za obavljanje stručnih zadataka, upravljanja projektima te preuzimanje etičke i društvene odgovornosti za rad na projektima u gospodarskim i izvangospodarskim djelatnostima.

Diplomski sveučilišni studij

Diplomski sveučilišni studij na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku traje 2 godine (4 semestra). Nakon završetka diplomskoga sveučilišnoga studija student ostvaruje 120 ECTS bodova i stječe akademski naziv magistar/magistra ekonomije ili skraćeno mag. oec. Uvjet za upis na diplomski studij je završen preddiplomski sveučilišni studij ili preddiplomski stručni studij (uz polaganje razlikovnog programa) te ostvarenih (minimalno) 180 ECTS-a.

Ekonomska fakultet u Osijeku nudi pet diplomskih studija: Ekonomska politika i regionalni razvitak, Financijski menadžment, Marketing, Poduzetništvo i Poslovna ekonomija na kojemu studenti mogu odabrati jedan od tri smjera: Poslovna informatika, Trgovina i logistika i Menadžment.

Završetkom diplomskoga sveučilišnoga studija student stječe znanja i vještine koje mu daju mogućnost obavljanja različitih složenih poslova upravljanja i vođenja razvojnih aktivnosti, donošenja odluka u uvjetima visoke nesigurnosti i kompleksnosti, preuzimanja osobne i timske odgovornosti za strateško odlučivanje i izvršenje zadataka kao i preuzimanja društvene i etičke odgovornosti u svim područjima gospodarske i izvangospodarske djelatnosti.



Poslijediplomski sveučilišni studiji – doktorski i specijalistički

Poslijediplomski studijski programi dijele se na poslijediplomske sveučilišne doktorske studije i poslijediplomske sveučilišne specijalističke studije.

Na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku izvode se dva doktorska poslijediplomska studija: poslijediplomski sveučilišni (doktorski) studij Menadžment i poslijediplomski međusveučilišni interdisciplinarni (doktorski) studij Poduzetništvo i inovativnost.

Doktorski studij traje 3 godine (180 ECTS bodova) i njegovim završetkom student stječe akademski stupanj doktora/doktorice znanosti iz područje društvenih znanosti, polje ekonomija (dr. sc.).

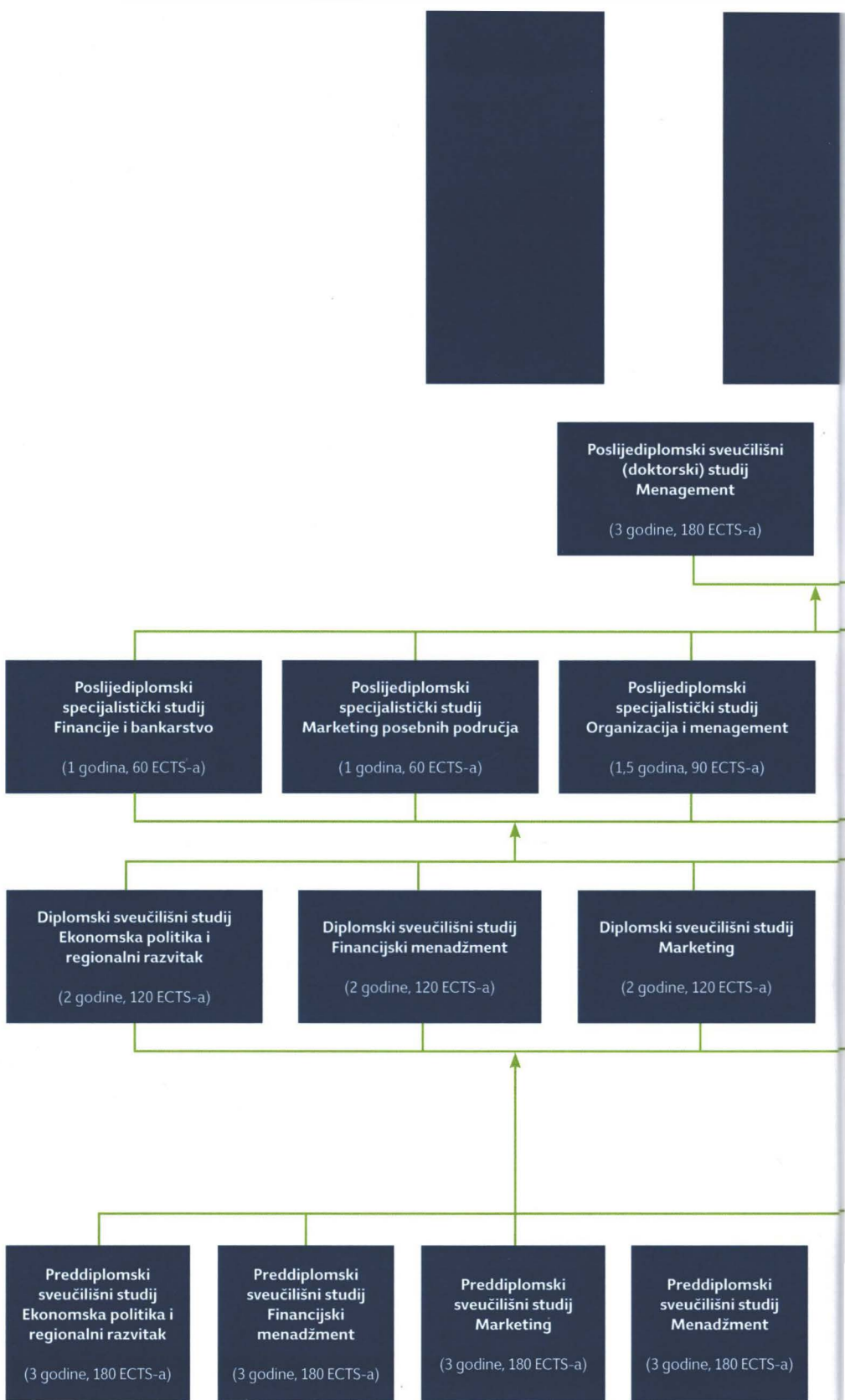
Završetkom doktorskoga studija, studenti su osposobljeni za rad na znanstvenoistraživačkim projektima, korištenje naprednih znanstvenih metoda, kao i za kreiranje i vrednovanje novih činjenica, za izražavanje osobnoga i profesionalnoga autoriteta te za preuzimanje etičke i društvene odgovornosti za uspješnost provođenja istraživanja, za društvenu korisnost rezultata istraživanja, kao i za posljedice tih istraživanja.

Na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku izvodi se šest poslijediplomskih specijalističkih studija: Financije i bankarstvo, Marketing posebnih područja, Organizacija i menadžment, Poduzetništvo, Upravljanje ekonomskim razvojem i Računovodstvo, revizija i analiza.

Poslijediplomski specijalistički studiji organizirani su u trajanju od 2 ili 3 semestra, ovisno o studiju, a završetkom poslijediplomskog specijalističkog studija stječe se 60 ili 90 ECTS bodova i akademski naziv sveučilišni/a specijalist/specijalistica uz naznaku struke ili dijela struke sukladno nazivu studijskog programa, što se označava kraticom univ. spec. oec.

Završetkom specijalističkih poslijediplomskih studija, studenti stječu specijalizirana znanja iz pojedinih područja koja im daju mogućnost obavljanja složenih poslova, kreativno i kritičko razmišljanje u rješavanju složenih problema te bolje snalaženje i pozicioniranje u uvjetima visoke konkurentnosti društva u kojemu žive i djeluju.

Izvanastavne aktivnosti

Studentske udruge

Na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku djeluje sedam studentskih udruga: Student-ski zbor, Studentsko sportsko društvo EFOS, AIESEC, BOOKMARK, Poduzetnici bez granica – EWOB, Financijski impuls i ERUDIO kroz koje studenti sudjeluju u različitim izvanastavnim i sportskim aktivnostima i projektima. Studentske udruge omogućuju im kvalitetno međusobno druženje, kao i razvijanje znanja i vještina koje su im potrebne da spremniji i konkurentniji iziđu na tržište rada.

Ove udruge pokrivaju različita područja studentskih interesa pri čemu Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku aktivno sudjeluje u provođenju, mentoriranju i podršci njihovih projekata.

Suradnja s Hrvatskom udrugom poslodavaca

Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku u suradnji s Hrvatskom udrugom poslodavaca organizira stručne prakse za svoje studente. Cilj praksi je omogućiti studentima primjenu naučenih teorijskih znanja, razvijanje postojećih i dodatnih znanja i vještina, te upoznavanje stvarnoga poslovnoga svijeta. Studentske prakse su često i prvi korak za predstavljanje budućim poslodavcima, a često i dobra prilika za zapošljavanje.

Pravno-ekonomska klinika

Pravni i Ekonomski fakultet Sveučilišta Josipa Jurja Strossmayera u Osijeku su, uz potporu poduzetničkoga inkubatora BIOS, Centra za poduzetništvo Osijek, osječkih odvjetnika i Odvjetničke komore u Osijeku, pokrenuli interdisciplinarni projekt pod nazivom Pravno-ekonomska klinika. Ideja je ovoga projekta da se udruživanjem znanja studenata s Pravnoga i Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku, uz




mentorstva profesora i odvjetnika, pružaju besplatne savjetodavne usluge osječkim poduzećima, s ciljem stjecanja praktičnih znanja i vještina te povećanja zapošljivosti studenata obaju fakulteta.

E-marketing akademija

Kao dio izvannastavnih aktivnosti na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku, od 2014. godine, organizira se i napredna edukacija pod nazivom *“E-marketing akademija”* namijenjena studentima diplomskoga studija. Cilj ovoga edukativnoga programa, koji se organizira u suradnji s istaknutim i priznatim stručnjacima u području elektroničkoga marketinga je popularizirati potencijale elektroničkoga marketinga u suvremenome poslovanju, ali i otvoriti mogućnosti za zapošljavanje studenata.

Volonterski program

Volonterski program na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku pokrenut je 2009. godine na inicijativu studija Poduzetništvo. Pod sloganom *“Volontiram – dakle, jesam”*, Volonterski program ima za cilj poticanje studentskoga volonterstva i razvoj socijalne osviještenosti i društvene odgovornosti među studentima.



Volonterski program surađuje i s drugim udrugama i institucijama poput Volonterskoga centra u Osijeku, Udruge za rad s mladima Breza, Dječjim domom Klasje i SOS dječjim selom Ladimirevci. Poticanjem volonterskoga rada kroz volonterski program želi se pomoći studentima u stjecanju iskustva u rješavanju problema u stvarnom svijetu te ih naučiti da prepoznaju prilike i budu proaktivni, što su važne osobine poduzetničkoga ponašanja svakoga pojedinca.

Gosti predavači

U nastavnome procesu na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku, na svim razinama i vrstama obrazovanja, važnu ulogu imaju gosti predavači, koji dolaze iz svih područja gospodarskoga, društvenoga i javnoga života. Prenoseći svoja iskustva studentima, obogaćuju sadržaje kolegija, doprinose njihovom boljem razumijevanju, a često se iz ovih aktivnosti rađaju i projekti različitih oblika suradnje između Ekonomskoga fakulteta i različitih institucija i poduzeća iz okruženja u koje se rado uključuju i studenti i profesori kao i predstavnici tih institucija i poduzeća.



Cjeloživotno obrazovanje na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku

U programe cjeloživotnoga učenja ubrajaju se svi oblici učenja tijekom života čija je svrha stjecanje i unaprjeđivanje kompetencija za osobne, društvene i profesionalne potrebe. Programi cjeloživotnoga učenja ne smatraju se studijem u smislu Zakona o znanstvenoj djelatnosti i visokom obrazovanju, ali su izuzetno važan dio obrazovnoga procesa u kojemu svaki pojedinac razvija i nadopunjuje vlastita znanja i vještine.

Svjestan trendova i potreba tržišta, Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku organizira i sudjeluje u izvođenju programa cjeloživotnoga obrazovanja, namijenjenih širokoj populaciji. Ponuda ovih programa mijenja se u skladu s potrebama tržišta, a u njihovom kreiranju i izvođenju uvijek sudjeluju i stručnjaci - predstavnici gospodarstva i lokalne zajednice. Postojeći programi se stalno revidiraju, osuvremenjuju i prilagođavaju potrebama gospodarstva i lokalne zajednice.

Neki od programa cjeloživotnoga obrazovanja na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku su: Upravljanje projektnim ciklusom, Seminar za turističke vodiče i voditelje poslovnica, Program za članove nadzornih odbora, Javna nabava, Cost & Benefit analiza troškova i koristi investicijskih projekata.

Nakon završetka nekoga od navedenih programa cjeloživotnoga obrazovanja, polaznici dobivaju potvrdu o završenome programu, a u nekim slučajevima i određeni broj ECTS bodova.



Znanstvenoistraživačka djelatnost na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku

Znanstvenoistraživačka djelatnost neodvojiv je dio aktivnosti Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku kao temelja budućega razvoja Fakulteta i u njegovom nastavnom smislu. Ona je usmjerena na istraživanje različitih područja društvenih zbiljanja, povezanih s poslovnom i ekonomskom problematikom u najširem smislu. Znanstvenoistraživačka djelatnost se primarno provodi kroz znanstvenoistraživački rad znanstvenika / istraživača na različitim znanstvenim projektima, koji rezultiraju brojnim znanstvenim i stručnim publikacijama.

Časopis Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku *Econviews/Ekonomski vjesnik* rezultat je napornoga rada na promicanju znanstvene izvrsnosti, što se dokazuje referiranjem objavljenih radova u poznatim i važnim svjetskim bazama kao što su: *Emerging Sources Citation Index*, *Web of Science*, *Thomson Reuters*, New York, USA, *Cab Abstracts (CAB International)*, Wallingford, United Kingdom, *EBSCOhost*, Ipswich, USA, *Econlit*, Pittsburgh, USA, *ABI/INFORM*, ProQuest, London, United Kingdom, Hrčak – Portal znanstvenih časopisa Republike Hrvatske (*MZOS*, *Srce* i *HID*), Hrvatska. *Ekonomski vjesnik* pohranjuje se i u hrvatskom arhivu weba.

Dio istraživača Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku čini istraživački tim *GEM (Global Entrepreneurship Monitor)* istraživanja za Hrvatsku, najvećega međunarodnoga znanstvenoga istraživanja o poduzetništvu, u kojemu Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku sudjeluje od 2002. godine.

Kao platformu za prikazivanje rezultata svojih znanstvenih projekata i istraživanja, istraživači najčešće koriste konferencije, koje su odlična prilika za razmjenu ideja i mišljenja, rezultata znanstvenih i stručnih projekata i istraživanja, ali i za umrežavanje sa znanstvenicima i istraživačima iz Hrvatske i inozemstva. Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku domaćin je velikome broju međunarodnih znanstvenih konferencija i simpozija, od kojih možemo izdvojiti: *Business Logistics in Modern Management*, *Economy of Eastern Croatia - vision and growth*, *Interdisciplinary Management Research*, *International Conference on Operational Research*, *Osijek-Pforzheim Symposium* itd.

Popularizacija znanosti

Aktivnosti i projekti popularizacije znanosti važan su dio znanstvenoistraživačkoga rada Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku, kroz koji se rezultati znanstvenih istraživanja čine dostupnima široj javnosti. To je ujedno i dobra platforma za povezivanje teorije i prakse, kako za studente, tako i za nastavnike i istraživače. Već su tradicionalnima postale: Znanstveni forum Katedre za nacionalnu i međunarodnu ekonomiju, Susret znanosti i gospodarstva, Kreativna riznica kao popularizacijski simpozij kreativne i kulturne industrije, EFOS EU tjedan, Globalni tjedan poduzetništva, Globalni tjedan novca, Dani marketinga na EFOS-u i drugi.

Knjižnica

Knjižnica Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku osnovana je istodobno s osnutkom Ekonomskoga fakulteta i od tada je njegov sastavni dio. Danas djeluje u sastavu Fakulteta kao posebna ustrojbenja jedinica u funkciji obrazovanja i osposobljavanja studenata i kao informacijska potpora znanstvenoistraživačkom radu nastavnoga osoblja. Ukupan knjižnični fond bliži se brojci od 40 000 svezaka knjižne građe i 125 naslova stručnih i znanstvenih časopisa i novina. Sadržaj knjižničnoga fonda obuhvaća sve udžbenike, priručnike, zbirku magistarskih i doktorskih radova te ostalu stručnu i



znanstvenu literaturu koja je potrebna za studij ekonomskih znanosti. Korisnici knjižnice su studenti Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku (redoviti, izvanredni, polaznici poslijediplomskih studija, doktorandi), profesori, predavači, asistenti i suradnici Ekonomskoga i drugih fakulteta Sveučilišta J. J. Strossmayera u Osijeku, gospodarstvenici i ostali građani.

Ured za studente s invaliditetom

Iako je broj studenata s invaliditetom na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku malen, u odnosu na ukupan broj upisanih studenata, Ekonomski fakultet u Osijeku čini značajan iskorak u pružanju potpore studentima s invaliditetom s ciljem njihove prilagodbe u akademskoj zajednici. Osobama s invaliditetom osiguran je nesmetan prilaz i ulaz u zgradu, kao i kretanje u gotovo cijeloj zgradi te su im učinjeni dostupnima i svi sadržaji na Fakultetu: od knjižnice, studentske referade, dvorana i sanitarnoga čvora. Na Ekonomskome fakultetu u Osijeku djeluje koordinator za studente s invaliditetom, koji je poveznica između studenata s invaliditetom s jedne strane i profesora, te stručnoga i administrativnoga osoblja Fakulteta s druge strane, a ujedno je i poveznica studenata sa sveučilišnim Uredom za studente s invaliditetom. Imenovanjem koordinatora za studente s invaliditetom slijedi se primjer dobre prakse razvijenih europskih sveučilišta. Koordinator za studente s invaliditetom pruža informacije, ali i izravnu podršku, pomoć i prilagodbu studentima s invaliditetom pri rješavanju njihovih problema.

Udruga ALUMNI Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku

Udruga Alumni EFOS osnovana je u veljači 2015. godine s ciljem izgradnje i održavanje veze između Ekonomskoga fakulteta u Osijeku i njegovih bivših studenata. Svojim svakodnevnim djelovanjem u zajednici, članovi udruge ALUMNI predstavljaju Fakultet i doprinose izgradnji njegove prepoznatljivosti, a članstvo u udruzi ALUMNI im omogućava umrežavanje i razmjenu iskustva i znanja s ostalim studentima, te održavanje veze s Ekonomskim fakultetom u Osijeku.

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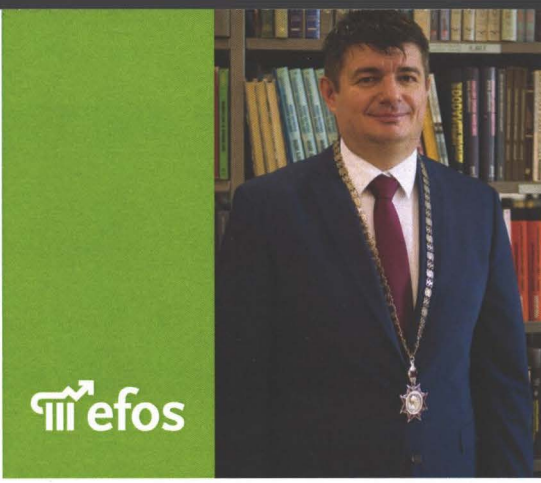

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


Dean's Note

The Faculty of Economics in Osijek is one of the oldest faculties and higher education institutions in Osijek and Slavonia and Baranja, and from the very first days of its existence it strives to position itself as an autonomous, modern, comparatively competitive institution, close to European and world quality standards of teaching and scientific research.

The Faculty of Economics in Osijek played a significant role in educating scientists and experts in this part of Croatia. Our students are our greatest achievement, people who have completed studies at our Faculty and who today hold the most responsible position in the economy, state administration and local and regional self-government, not only in the region, but also throughout Croatia. Until March 2018, 9,566 students have graduated from university undergraduate studies, 3,375 students from undergraduate and 2,779 students from graduate studies, 601 students have completed postgraduate specialist studies, 691 students have earned master's degrees, while 268 candidates have earned doctorate degrees at the Faculty.

The strength of the Faculty rests, above all, on highly educated and highly motivated teachers and scientists who are drivers of all the Faculty's key activities. 49 teachers in scientific-teaching titles (full and associate professors, assistant professors) and 18 associates and teachers (assistants and lecturers) are currently employed at the Faculty. The quality of the teaching process is greatly enhanced by the involvement of a large number of external associates who are acknowledged experts from economic life. The



enthusiasm and new views of a large number of young teachers, together with the wealth of experience of mature generations, are precious as a starting point for future development of the Faculty.

In its, more than 50 years long, history, as the external circumstances changed, the so did the Faculty. The changes were primarily related to the adaptation of the Faculty's study programmes to the needs of the labour market. Thus, since 2005, Faculty offers study programmes adapted to the Bologna system. The entire educational vertical of university studies, from undergraduate to doctoral studies, is being conducted at the Faculty today. The Faculty's resources and a large number of highly educated teachers enable development of quality study programmes, which are being developed both in depth and in breadth. The Faculty presently offers studying at six study programmes in business economics and one programme in economics. In addition, a large number of elective courses allows students to customize the study programme to their own preferences and wishes.

For many years, through its vision and mission, the Faculty of Economics in Osijek is demonstrating its commitment to the promotion and achievement of excellence in its scientific-research and teaching activities, as an important prerequisite for achieving progress and competitiveness of the society in which it lives and operates.

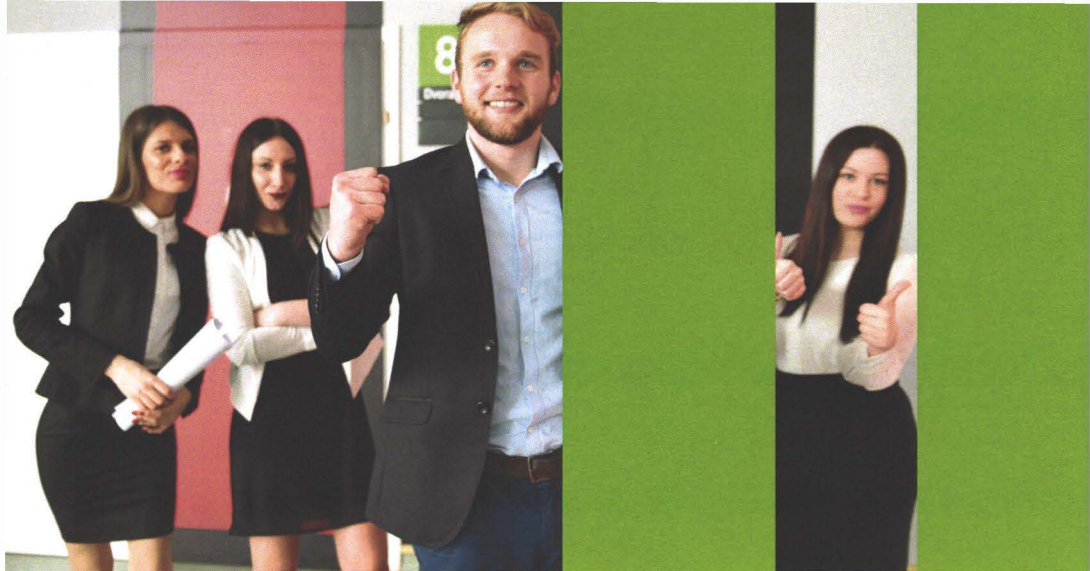




About Osijek

Osijek is a city in Eastern Croatia, located on the right bank of the river Drava. It is the largest city in Slavonia, the fourth largest city in Croatia and the administrative centre of the Osijek-Baranja County. The City of Osijek has for centuries been an important political, cultural and commercial, and recently also a tourist centre of this part of Croatia. The city itself has 84,000 inhabitants, while in the administrative area of the City of Osijek (Osijek and 10 suburban settlements) there are 108,048 inhabitants (according to the 2011 Census). The tradition of higher education in Osijek dates back to 1707, when the first institution of higher education was established in Osijek. Today, about 16,500 students attend the Josip Juraj Strossmayer University of Osijek.





About the Faculty of Economics in Osijek

The Faculty of Economics in Osijek is one of the oldest faculties of the Josip Juraj Strossmayer University of Osijek. It was founded in 1961, as continuation of activities of the Centre for Economic Studies of the University of Zagreb, with great support of the economy of the time, chamber of economy, and institutions of local and regional authorities. This "regional" foundation has determined the profile of the faculty since the very beginning: focused on problems of regional development and enterprise development in research work, and focused on issues of organisation of operations and enterprise management in educational programmes.

The Faculty has 67 employees in scientific-teaching and associate titles, and 35 professional-administrative, technical and auxiliary staff. With their dedicated work, they all strive to increase the quality of service and recognisability of the Faculty of Economics as a centre of excellence.

What makes it different from the others are numerous opportunities that it provides for students: a large number of study programmes at all levels of education, many extracurricular activities through which students develop their knowledge and skills and increase their employability, as well as cooperation at national and international level with higher education institutions and business entities on various scientific and professional projects, as well as on mobility projects, through the Erasmus+ program. Some of the European universities with which Faculty of Economics has signed agreements on bilateral cooperation are: University of Vienna, University of Business in Prague, Universitat Augsburg, HHL Leipzig Graduate School of Management, Pforzheim University, University of Malaga, Murcia University, Kaposvar University, University of Pecs, University of Bari Aldo Moro, Hanze University of Applied Sciences Groningen.

As proof of quality of scientific research work, educational process, as well as on organisation of operations and organisation management system, the Faculty of Economics in Osijek is the holder of several quality accreditations: accreditation of the Agency for Science and Higher Education of the



Republic of Croatia, thereby proving that it meets all the legal requirements for successfully carrying out its activities in the Republic of Croatia, and IQA accreditation (CEEMAN International Quality Accreditation), certifying the high quality of the programme and its implementation, personnel potential and equipment, as well as the final results of the activity.

The Certificate of Compliance with ISO 9001:2008 standard, which the Faculty received in 2013, as well as the ISO 22301 Certificate, which the Faculty received in 2016, serve as confirmation of a successful organisation management system.

In 2008, UNESCO Chair in Entrepreneurship was established at the Faculty of Economics, which is awarded to institutions and individuals for outstanding achievement in a field.

Through its vision and mission, the Faculty of Economics in Osijek is proving its commitment to the promotion and achievement of excellence in its scientific research and teaching activities, as an important prerequisite for achieving progress and competitiveness of the society in which it lives and operates.

Vision

The vision of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek is to be recognisable as the standard of excellence in education and development of future business leaders, build and maintain a leading society of economic experts and business people at regional, state and international level.



Mission

The mission of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek is to enhance the quality of higher education through teaching, scientific research work, and continuous cooperation with other higher education institutions and business entities.

The mission of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek is to educate students capable of socio-economic development of Croatia by providing academic and lifelong education in the field of economics and business economics. To acquire scientific achievements, critically evaluate them and create new knowledge through scientific-research work in the field of economics and its related sciences. To be a socially responsible institution of high academic values and ethical principles that ensures equality and prosperity to its members, students and society as a whole.

Faculty's equipment

Strategic orientation of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek dedicates special attention to the continuous improvement of information technology and the expansion of educational content that directly relies on the use of ICT. The implementation of the Bologna declaration resulted in the introduction of new educational content that encourages creative use of information and communication technologies. Some programmes at the Faculty are already being carried out using distance learning technology, which enables students who are geographically dislocated and are unable to come to Osijek to participate in the programmes.

There are over 200 personal computers at students' disposal at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek. All classrooms of the Faculty of Economics are equipped with multimedia equipment for quality delivery of the educational process (computer connected to the Internet, projector and sound system) and an interactive board is also available. The equipment is continuously renewed and adapted to the latest trends in the ICT industry.



Study programmes at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek

There are currently about 3,000 students attending some of the educational programmes of undergraduate, graduate or postgraduate level at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek.

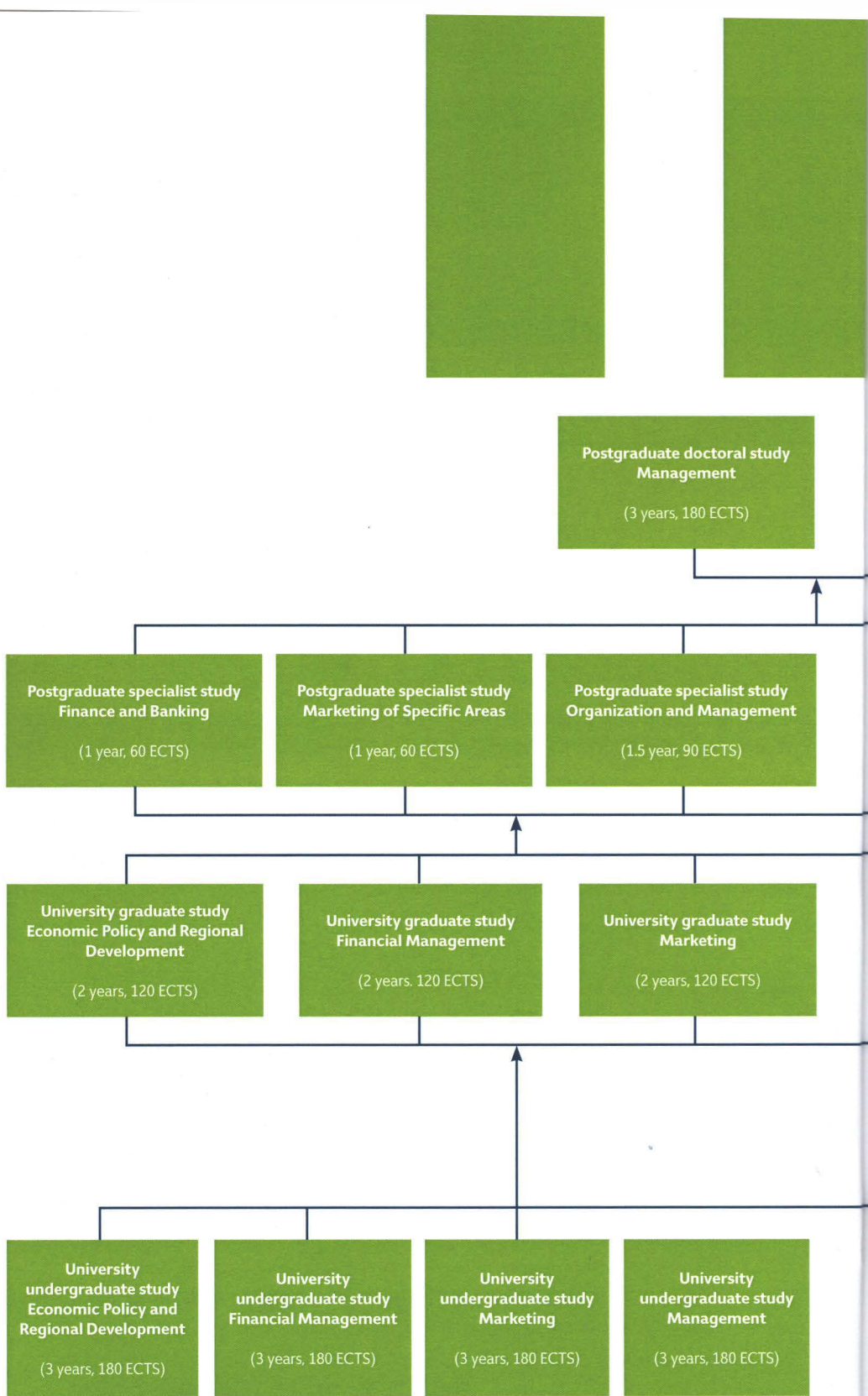


Figure 1. Study programmes at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek

Teaching at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek is organised in accordance with the Bologna reform in three levels of university education: undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate level, at which study programmes in economics and business economics are offered (Figure 1).

In 57 years of its existence, 12,345 students have graduated from the Faculty, 3,375 students have received the academic title of University Bachelor of Economics, while 991 students have received the title of Professional Bachelor of Economics.

Since their establishment in 1973, 1,828 students have finished postgraduate studies, of which 691 students have earned the academic degree of Master of Science, 601 students have earned the academic title of University Specialist, while 268 doctors of science have earned their doctorates at the Faculty.

Undergraduate professional study

Undergraduate professional study at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek lasts three years (six semesters), and students can choose one of the two offered studies: undergraduate professional study Accounting or undergraduate



professional study Trade. Upon the completion of the study students are awarded 180 ECTS credits and the degree of Professional Bachelor of Economics (baccalaureus/baccalaurea) or abbreviated: bacc.oec.

The most important feature of this study lies in the fact that it prepares students for independent and practical work after completing their studies. The study covers theoretical and practical knowledge that is directly applicable in practice and necessary for carrying out daily activities and tasks.

Undergraduate university study

Undergraduate university study at the Faculty of Economics lasts three years (6 semesters) and upon its completion students are awarded 180 ECTS credits and the academic title of University Bachelor of Economics (baccalaureus/baccalaurea) or abbreviated: univ.bacc.oec.

There are 6 study programmes at the undergraduate level at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek, 1 in the field economics: Economic Policy and Regional Development and 5 in the field of business economics: Financial Management, Management, Marketing, Entrepreneurship and Business Informatics. Upon completion of the undergraduate university study, students are qualified to perform professional tasks, manage projects, and assume the ethical and social responsibility for work on projects in both economic and non-economic activities.

Graduate university study

Graduate university study at the Faculty of Economics lasts 2 years (4 semesters). Upon completion of graduate university study, students are awarded 120 ECTS credits and the academic title of Master of Economics or abbreviated: mag.oec. The requirement for admission to graduate study is completed undergraduate university study or undergraduate professional study (with passed differential programme) and obtained (at least) 180 ECTS.

The Faculty of Economics in Osijek offers five graduate studies: Economic Policy and Regional Development, Financial Management, Marketing, Entrepreneurship and Business Economics, at which students can choose one of three majors: Business Informatics, Trade and Logistics, and Management. Upon completion of the graduate university study, students acquire knowledge and skills which enable them to perform a variety of complex tasks of managing and leading development activities, make decisions under conditions of high uncertainty and complexity, assume personal and team responsibility for strategic decision-making and execution of tasks, as well as to assume the social and ethical responsibility in all aspects of economic and non-economic activities.



Postgraduate university studies – doctoral and specialist

Postgraduate study programmes are divided into postgraduate doctoral studies and postgraduate specialist studies.

Two postgraduate doctoral studies are carried out at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek: postgraduate university (doctoral) study Management and postgraduate inter-university interdisciplinary (doctoral) study Entrepreneurship and Innovativeness.

Doctoral study lasts 3 years (180 ECTS) and upon its completion students are awarded the academic degree of Doctor of Science in the area of Social Sciences, field of Economics (Ph.D.).

Upon completion of doctoral study, students are qualified to work on scientific research projects, use advanced scientific methods, as well as to create and evaluate new facts, to express personal and professional authority, and to assume the ethical and social responsibility for successful implementation of research, for social usefulness of research results, as well as for the consequences of the research.

There are six postgraduate specialist studies carried out at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek: Finance and Banking, Marketing of Special Areas, Organisation and Management, Entrepreneurship, Development Management and Accounting, Audit and Analysis.

Postgraduate specialist studies are organised in duration of 2 or 3 semesters, depending on the study, and upon completion of the postgraduate specialist study students are awarded 60 or 90 ECTS credits and the academic title University Specialist with the indication of the profession or part of the profession in accordance with the name of the study programme, which is denoted by the abbreviation: univ.spec.oec.

Upon completion of specialist postgraduate studies, students acquire specialised knowledge in specific areas that give them the ability to perform complex tasks, creative and critical thinking in solving complex problems, and better coping and positioning under conditions of high competitiveness of the society in which they live and work.

Extracurricular activities

Student associations

There are seven active student associations at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek: Student Union, Students' Sports Association EFOS, AIESEC, BOOK-MARK, Entrepreneurs Without Borders – EWOB, Financial Impulse and ERU-DIO, through which students participate in a variety of extra-curricular and sporting activities and projects, socialise and develop their knowledge and skills, in order to be better prepared and more competitive in the labour market.

These associations cover different areas of students' interests and the Faculty of Economics in Osijek actively participates in the implementation, mentoring and supporting their projects.

Cooperation with the Croatian Employers' Association

In cooperation with the Croatian Employers' Association, Faculty of Economics in Osijek organises internships for its students. The goal of internships is to enable students to apply the learned theoretical knowledge, develop existing and acquire new knowledge and skills, and become familiar with the real business world. Student internships are often the first step for presentation to future employers, and often a good opportunity for employment.

Legal-Economic Clinic

The Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Economics of the Josip Juraj Strossmayer University of Osijek, with the support of Business Incubator BIOS, Centre for Entrepreneurship Osijek, Osijek's lawyers and Bar Association in Osijek have started an interdisciplinary project called Legal-Economic Clinic. The idea of this project is, through synergy of knowledge of students from the Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Economics in Osijek, with


mentoring by professors and lawyers, to provide free counselling services to Osijek companies, with the aim of gaining practical knowledge and skills, and increasing the employability of students of both faculties.

E-Marketing Academy

As part of extra-curricular activities at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek, advanced training called “E-Marketing Academy” intended for students of graduate studies is being carried out since 2014. The aim of this educational programme, which is organised in cooperation with prominent and recognised experts in the field of electronic marketing, is to popularise the potential of electronic marketing in modern business, but also to open up employment opportunities for students.

Volunteer Programme

The Volunteer Programme at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek was launched in 2009 on the initiative of the Study Programme in Entrepreneurship. Under the slogan “*I volunteer –therefore, I am*” the Volunteer Programme aims to encourage student volunteerism and the development of social awareness and social responsibility among students. Volunteer Programme cooperates with other associations and institutions, such as Volunteer Centre in Osijek, Youth Association Breza, Children’s Home Klasje



and SOS Children's Village Ladimirevci. By encouraging volunteer work, the Volunteer Programme seeks to help students gain experience in solving real-world problems, and teach them to recognize opportunities and be proactive, which are important components of entrepreneurial behaviour of each individual.

Guest lecturers

In the teaching process at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek, at all levels and types of education, an important role is played by guest lecturers who come from all segments of economic, social and public life. By conveying their experiences to students, they enrich the content of courses, contribute to their better understanding, and these activities often result in projects with various forms of cooperation between the Faculty of Economics and various institutions and companies from the environment in which both students and professors and representatives of those institutions and companies gladly participate.



Lifelong learning at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek

Lifelong learning programmes include all forms of learning throughout life whose purpose is the acquisition and improvement of competences for personal, professional and social needs. Lifelong learning programmes are not considered studies in the sense of the Act on Scientific Activity and Higher Education, but they are an extremely important segment of the educational process in which each individual develops and complements their own knowledge and skills.

Aware of trends and market needs, the Faculty of Economics in Osijek organises and participates in execution of lifelong learning programmes, intended for the general population. The offer of these programmes is changing in accordance with market needs, and in their design and execution always participate experts – representatives of the economy and the local community. The existing programmes are constantly revised, updated and adapted to the needs of the economy and the local community.

Some of the lifelong learning programmes at the Faculty of Economics are: Project Cycle Management, Seminar for Tourist Guides and Branch Managers, Programme for Members of Supervisory Boards, Public Procurement, Cost & Benefit Analysis of Investment Projects.

After completing one of the lifelong learning programmes, participants acquire a certificate of completion, and in some cases, a certain number of ECTS credits.



Scientific research activities at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek

Scientific research activities are an inseparable part of the activities of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek, as the foundation for future development of the Faculty also in teaching terms. They are focused on the exploration of different segments of social events related to business and economic issues in the broadest sense. Scientific research activities are primarily carried out through scientific research work of scientists/researchers on various scientific projects, which result in numerous scientific and professional publications.

The journal of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek *Econviews / Ekonomski vjesnik* is the result of hard work on the promotion of scientific excellence, which is evidenced by indexing of the articles published in the journal in renowned and important international databases such as:

Emerging Sources Citation Index, Web of Science, Thomson Reuters, New York, USA, Cab Abstracts (CAB International), Wallingford, United Kingdom, EBSCOhost, Ipswich, USA, Econlit, Pittsburgh, USA, ABI/INFORM, ProQuest, London, United Kingdom, Hrčak – Portal of Scientific Journals of Croatia (MZOS, Srce and HID), Croatia. *Ekonomski vjesnik* is also stored in the Croatian Web Archive.

Several researchers from the Faculty of Economics in Osijek are part of the GEM research team (Global Entrepreneurship Monitor) for Croatia, the largest international scientific study on entrepreneurship, in which the Faculty of Economics has been participating since 2002.

Researchers most often use conferences as a platform for the presentation of the results of their projects and studies, which are an excellent opportunity for exchange of ideas and opinions, the results of scientific and professional projects and studies, but also for networking with scientists and researchers from Croatia abroad. Faculty of Economics in Osijek hosts a large number of international scientific conferences and symposia, from which we can single out: Business Logistics in Modern Management, Economy of Eastern Croatia - Vision and Growth, Interdisciplinary Management Research, International Conference on Operational Research, Osijek-Pforzheim Symposium, etc.

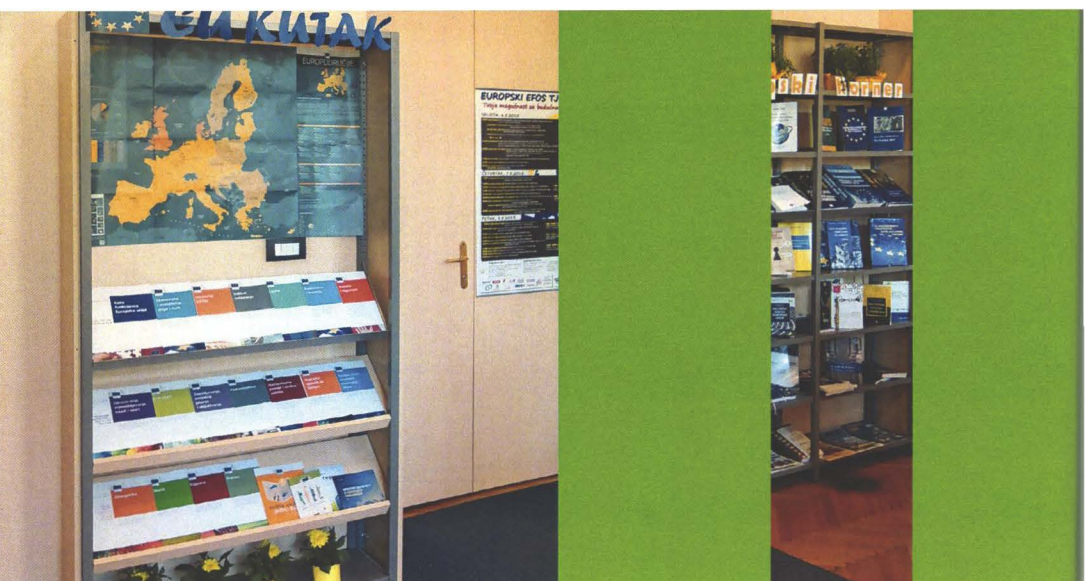


Popularisation of science

Activities and projects of popularisation of science are an important segment of scientific research work of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek, through which the results of scientific research are made available to the general public. This is also a good platform to connect theory and practice, both for students and for teachers and researchers. Some of these have already become traditional, such as: Scientific Forum of the Chair of National and International Economics, Encounter of Science and Economy, Creative Treasury, popularisation symposium of creative and cultural industries, EFOS EU Week, Global Entrepreneurship Week, Days of Marketing at EFOS, and others.

Library

The library of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek was established simultaneously with the establishment of the Faculty of Economics and has since been an integral part thereof. Today it operates within the Faculty as a separate organisational unit in the function of education and training of students and as information support to scientific research work of the teaching staff. The total library collection is nearing the number of 40,000



volumes of library materials and 125 titles of professional and scientific journals and newspapers. The content of the library collection includes all textbooks, manuals, collection of master's theses and doctoral dissertations and other professional and scientific literature, which is necessary to study economics.

Library users are students of the Faculty of Economics (full time and part-time students, postgraduate students, doctoral students), professors, teachers, assistants and associates of the Faculty of Economics and other faculties of the J.J. Strossmayer University of Osijek, businessmen and other citizens.

Office for Students with Disabilities

Although the number of students with disabilities at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek is small compared to the total number of enrolled students, Faculty of Economics in Osijek is making significant efforts to provide support to students with disabilities with the aim of their adjustment in the academic community. Disabled persons are provided unrestricted access and entrance to the building, as well as movement in almost the entire building, and all the facilities at the Faculty have been made accessible to them: library, student administration office, lecture halls and bathrooms. A coordinator for students with disabilities operates at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek, acting as the link between students with disabilities on the one hand, and teachers and professional and administrative staff of the Faculty on the other hand, and at the same time serves as student's link with the University Office for Students with Disabilities. The appointment of the coordinator for students with disabilities follows the example of good practice of developed European universities. Through its activities, the coordinator for students with disabilities provides information, but also direct support, assistance and adjustment to students with disabilities in solving their problems.



ALUMNI of the Faculty of Economics in Osijek

The Alumni EFOS Association was established in February 2015 aiming to build and maintain connections between the Faculty of Economics in Osijek and its former students. With their everyday activities in the community, members of the Alumni represent the Faculty and contribute to building its image, while membership in the Alumni Association allows them to network and exchange experiences and knowledge with other students, and to maintain a connection with the Faculty of Economics in Osijek.

Some of the activities of the Alumni EFOS Association are **Leadership Forum**, whose aim is to share the experiences of leaders in their examples of achieving excellence in building teams, running businesses, starting a change in the communities in which they live and work, and participation of alumni members as guest lecturers at the Faculty of Economics in Osijek.

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
